## HOW WE LOVE – by Kay & Milan Yerkovich - Facilitators: Steven & Debra Twiss

In How We Love, relationship experts Milan and Kay Yerkovich draw on the powerful tool of attachment theory to show how your early life experiences created an “intimacy imprint”—an underlying blueprint that shapes your behavior, beliefs, and expectations of all relationships, especially your marriage. They identify four types of injured imprints that combine in marriage to trap couples in a repetitive dance of pain. The Marriage Ministry Team and a few other invitees will be previewing this material with a view to opening it to others in the congregation in the future.

In this video-based study, Lorie shares her story of struggle. Teenagers running from God, addiction, hopelessness and fear – what was happening to her family? Lorie’s dynamic teaching will take you on a journey to freedom, through powerful storytelling and teaching from God’s Word. ## HIS WORKMANSHIP - Beta Discipleship Course - Teacher & Facilitator: Valerie Peters

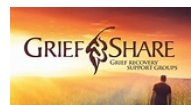
